- This form has been designed by Leicestershire Netball for application to be made by a club coach or responsible adult team member for a young person UNDER 16 years to play in any of the Leicestershire Netball adult leagues.
- Only one application needs to be made to cover any league.
- The application must be completed by the club coach or responsible adult team member and then signed and dated by all concerned.
- If the Young Person is a member of the **England Netball Performance** or is **under 14 years of age**, the completed form must go to Donna Swann or Val Kindred.
